Smooth, Rich, Chocolate roasted notes with hints of coffee & caramel.

Malt led in taste, balanced with a roasty nuttiness and citrus overtones.

This porter is the definition of flavour. Deep coffee and malt notes Long bitter finish.

It's soft and rounded and giving you coffee, chocolate and dark, smoke aromas.

**Pale**

A nutty, caramel-malt body with sweet red fruit notes and a gently bitter finish.

**4.5%**
**Pale**

Pale ale with mango, apricot and apple notes, designed to quench the strongest of thirsts.

An excessively dark stout, strong in content and strong in flavour.

Northern IPA****5.2%****IPA**

Plenty of citrus and tropical fruit flavours from a blend of US hops.

Prime Porter****4.9%****Porter**

Aromas of dark chocolate, treacle sweet flavours, roasted bitterness and fruitiness.

**43****Hop Union – Bristol  
Scallywag****4.8%****Bitter**

Pale Chocolate and Caramalt in the mash give the dark amber colour.

**45****Ilkey – Yorkshire  
Mary Jane****3.4%****Pale**

Intensely refreshing and satisfying, with surprising balance for such a low ABV.

**47****Jolly Boys – Yorkshire  
Supa Citra APA****4.2%****APA**

Hoppy & Citrusy Very Moorish.

**49****Kirby Lonsdale – Cumbria  
Monumental****4.5%****Golden**

A golden ale brewed with pale malt, blended with English and Slovenian Golding Hops.

**51****Little Criters – Sheffield  
Spot On****4.3%****Pale**

Classic Pale Ale with a complex citrus and hoppy aroma.

**53****Loch Lomond – Scotland  
Silkie Stout****4.0%****Oatmeal Stout**

A roast coffee and rich chocolate flavour, rounded off with a smooth and creamy finish.

**38****Hadrian Border – Newcastle  
Tyneside Blonde****3.9%****Blonde**

Maris otter malt, wheat malt and an abundance of bittering and aromatic hops.

**40****Hawkstead – Cumbria  
Mosaic****4.0%****Pale**

Pale malt base, with carapils and malted oats added to give a lightly toasted complexity.

**42****Hop Union – Bristol  
Moose River****5.0%****APA**

Centennial and Tettnang hops for depth and aroma, and Mosaic hops for tropical flavour.

**44****Ilkey – Yorkshire  
Joshua Jane****3.4%****Amber**

Rich nut-brown colour and the soft caramel flavour is fused with unique hop character.

**46****Jolly Boys – Yorkshire  
Collier Porter****5.0%****Porter**

Crystal malt, caramel-toffee flavours. Black malt, hints of burnt coffee.

**48****Kirby Lonsdale – Cumbria  
Jubilee Stout****5.5%****Stout**

A smooth stout brewed with chocolate and black malts, and just a hint of roasted barley.

**50****Little Criters – Sheffield  
White Wolf****5.0%****APA**

This is a refreshing light beer, smooth from the high quality malt, with a crisp citrus finish.

**52****Loch Lomond – Scotland  
Lost in Mosaic****5.0%****IPA**

Pineapple and citrus lead on to oranges and melon followed by a fresh citrus finish.

**54****Maxim (Tyne & Wear)  
Maximus****6.0%****Strong**

A warming beer that is also smooth and easy to drink.



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**55****Maxim (Tyne & Wear)  
Double Maxim****4.7%****Dark**

This premium ale is still famous for its well-rounded flavour.

**57****Marble – Manchester  
Marble Pint****3.9%****Pale**

Clean citrus hop flavour with pale malt base. Dry bitter aftertaste and lasting hop.

**59****Moorhouses – Lancashire  
Pride of Pendle****4.1%****Amber**

Light amber ale that is balanced with biscuit malt and hops to give a delectably dry taste.

**61****Nailmaker – Yorkshire  
Plum Porter****4.4%****Porter**

An easy drinking and well rounded porter with the bitter sweet fusion of yummy plums.

**63****Oakham – Cambridge  
Bishops Farewell****4.6%****Golden**

Smooth, malty background, rich and fruity hop flavours and a refreshing finish.

**65****Old Mill – Yorkshire  
Oatmeal Stout****4.2%****Oatmeal Stout**

Roasted malts with caramel, chocolate, and mild coffee notes. Well balanced flavour!

**67****Pennine – Yorkshire  
Pennine IPA****4.4%****IPA**

Zesty fruits, mild liquorice and black pepper undertones create the perfect balance.

**69****Pictish – Lancashire  
Porter****4.4%****Porter**

Bitterness and subtle hop aroma balance the robust amber and roast malt flavours.

Loose Change****4.0%****Pale**

Session pale ale hopped with Citra, Idaho 7, Idaho 7 Cryo and Nelson Sauvin.

**56****Marble – Manchester  
Marble Stout****5.7%****Stout**

Stout featuring a deep, dark color and rich, complex malt layers.

**58****Moorhouses – Lancashire  
Pendle Witches Brew****5.1%****Strong**

A bold, malty amber beer with spice fruit notes and crisp fruity aftertaste.

**60****Nailmaker – Yorkshire  
Yorkshire Bitter****3.6%****Bitter**

Just as you would expect a Yorkshire Bitter to be, deliciously quaffable.

**62****Oakham – Cambridge  
Green Devil****6.0%****IPA**

Hop harvest aromas, big tropical and citrus hop flavours before a crisp, refreshing finish.

**64****Old Mill – Yorkshire  
Styrian Wolf****4.2%****Pale**

Sweet tropical fruits and complex aromas of mango, elderflowers and even a hint of violet.

**66****Pennine – Yorkshire  
Hair of the Dog (Vegan)****3.9%****Blonde**

Fruity hop burst, sweet after taste and refreshing to the palate.

**68****Pictish – Lancashire  
Cashmere****4.1%****Pale**

A traditional English pale ale that is bursting with flavour.

**70****Pool – Blackpool  
Bending Corners****5.0%****Golden**

Azacca, El Dorado, Mosaic and US Cascade hops give citrusy and grapefruity flavours.

**72****Quantock (Somerset)  
Sauvin Sunshine****4.2%****Pale**

Bursting with tropical fruit character from Nelson Sauvin and Nectarone hops.

Malt backbone, rich biscuit and toffee, balanced by subtle floral character.

Weightless****4.2%****IPA**

Pithy grapefruit and mango flavours with a well-rounded body.

Maharaja****5.1%****IPA**

Packed with vibrant hop character, layers of citrus and ripe fruit, and a malt backbone.

**79****Rudgate – York  
Ruby Mild****4.4%****Ruby**

Ruby Red colour with complex and smoky flavours and a rich velvet finish.

**81****Salopian – Shrewsbury  
Lemon Dream****4.5%****Pale**

A zesty pale with fresh, hand-cut, lemons and fruity US hops for a subtle citrus zing.

**83****Settle – Cumbria  
Old Smithy Porter****4.7%****Porter**

A robust and creamy porter with deep notes of caramel and coffee.

**85****Skipton – Yorkshire  
Portcullis Porter****4.4%****Porter**

A dark chocolate, nutty malt and balanced bitterness.

Oot N'About****5.6%****IPA**

North American hops, yielding vibrant notes of citrus, mango, pineapple and stone fruits.

White Star****4.5%****Golden**

A distinctive, hoppy golden ale with a rich, fruity aroma and a full-bodied taste.

Rich biscuit and caramel malts, gentle earthy hops and a smooth, balanced finish.

Chocolate Stout****5.0%****Stout**

Rich stout with complex balanced flavours and a warm subtle chocolate finish.

Darwins Origin****4.3%****Bitter**

Zesty character descends into a long, lavish finish.

Ernies Milk Stout** (Contains Lactose)**4.5%****Stout**

Infused with roasted coffee and chocolate flavours, finished with a hint of sweetness.

First Pilgrim****3.4%****Pale**

Maris Otter forms a clean, bready base with a touch of crystal for gentle sweetness.

Nowt But Stout****4.2%****Oatmeal Stout**

Smooth, well-bodied stout. Featuring subtle chocolate, coffee, and charcoal undertones.

**88****Titanic – Staffordshire  
Plum Porter****4.9%****Porter**

Plum and other stone fruits are present, balanced against a delicate blend of hops.

**90****Titanic – Staffordshire  
Steerage****3.8%****Golden**

Delicate sweet malt aromas introduce a dry, refreshing taste with a subtle hop finish.

A fresh twist, delivering a refreshing taste that's simply irresistible.

**3.9%**
**Pale**

Soak up refreshing flavours and aromas of pine, peach, lychee and citrus.

**Weetwood – Cheshire Mad Hatter**
**3.9%**
**Ruby**

Brewed with Amarillo hops from the USA to give spicy and floral character.

Mango and tropical fruit, moves into spice, and resolves with a calm, rounded pale malt.

**4.0%**
**Amber**

A well-balanced classic pairing of Fuggles and Goldings hops.

**Vocation – Hebden Bridge Naughty & Nice**
**5.9%**
**Stout**

Chocolate, roasted barley and dark crystal malt give this stout a deep, rich flavour.

**Weetwood – Cheshire Harlequin**
**4.6%**
**Pale**

A pale ale which has crisp citrus hop notes, satisfying mouthfeel and a long, dry finish.

**Warfdale – Yorkshire Porter**
**5.0%**
**Porter**

Balanced with the late addition of Goldings hops and natural plum flavouring.

**Xtreme – Peterborough Triple Hop Xtra**
**5.0%**
**IPA**

A clean fresh taste, a slightly bitter finish and a little extra kick from a superior malt bill.
